Notes on Performance

This piece is based on most of the poem “Interspecies Communication” by Di Brandt, a celebration of the honeybee. Copyright permission secured from author.

The computer-generated music is designed so that the main tempo of quarter= 60 pertains throughout. Split-second coordination between ‘taped’ part and players isn’t necessary. Strong pitch centers in the fixed media part are indicated either by letter or notated.

Bold text indicates words spoken in electronic part.

Repeat boxed figure until end of heavy line.
