### *So Many Oceans*


Nobel Laureate Nelly Sachs wrote many haunting poems documenting the inner turmoil she experienced during and after the Holocaust. She lived in Germany until 1940 when she fled to Sweden and there spent the rest of her life. Reading these poems more than fifty years after they were written, I see also in her nature imagery, a lament not only for the Jewish people, but for the earth and its creatures. The English translations are my own. The third poem includes some of her German text.

So many dead abandoned in pearl eyes of fish.  
So many patterns of stars in shining crystal.

Behind the veil of secrets,  
You.
